WFAA will award “**ribbons**” for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each **category**.

Best in Show- \$500.00,

1st- \$300.00,

2nd- \$200.00

3rd- \$100.00 *We also have specialty sponsor awards

Eligible Media Includes:

Pottery, Tapestries, Textiles, Mixed Fiber Media, Leather Work, Porcelain, Sculptured Metal Work. Woodwork, Sculpture, (including Soft Sculpture), Stained Glass, Mosaic and Porcelain.

Pieces must have been produced in the last two years

(Clothing, Jewelry, Weapons and Trappings are not acceptable at this time.)

Number of entries and entry fees:

There is a **non-refundable** \$35.00 charge for one (1) to three (3) pieces, limited to a total of three pieces submitted. (The payment for work **not** accepted will **not** be returned.) Payment is required at the time of submission. Pieces will be accepted or declined without explanation.

jpeg images should include a front, side and back photo.
jpegs should be 1920 pixels on the long side and 72 dpi

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Pieces cannot exceed a total of **204"**. Length + Width x 2 (measure height and width this equals an amount, then times that number by 2 for a total.) Must be 204 or less.

Sculptures must fit in a 18 x 20 x18 box.

2. Artwork pieces must weigh less than 40 pounds.

3. You must indicate the direction or placement of your piece (up and the front)

4. All fiber artwork on canvas must be wired with D-rings, or other secure fasteners.

No SAWTOOTH hangers.

5. All artists will be responsible for their own insurance. WFAA will not be responsible for loss or damage of any artwork.

6. All mailed and shipped pieces must include pre-paid return shipping label with a barcode for return of unsold works. No shipping peanuts.

7.. Each piece selected must have a completed entry form attached.

8.. No classroom or workshop pieces.

WFAA will receive a **20% commission** of the selling price. Payment for pieces sold will be disbursed two weeks after the closing of the show. Artists with purchased artwork will be responsible for their own taxes.

WFAA reserves the right of approval for all entries in the show.

WFAA reserves the right to photograph artwork and use artist or entry information for publicity purposes. In addition, the entrant understands that **any work not picked up** on the designated take down days without prior arrangements will be stored for a **\$10.00 a week** fee and then considered **abandoned** after 30 days following the end of the show. It becomes the property of WFAA and will be **sold** to assist funding projects.

Artwork must remain on exhibit for the duration of the show. If an artist removes artwork they will forfeit entry into the next three shows.
